

2013/2014 High School New Student Information

Calvary Chapel High School was established to meet the educational, social, and spiritual needs of the children of Calvary Chapel of Costa Mesa, pastored by Pastor Chuck Smith. CCHS is a ministry of CCCM, building up Christian leaders in mind, body, and soul through Biblical truth, character development, and strong academic pursuits enabling students to serve and enjoy Christ and their community. All of our classes are taught by teachers who love Jesus, love teaching, and love their students. It is our desire to build a solid foundation of knowledge while also ministering to the needs of the whole child. We do not seek those that do not have a relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ. Below you will find some basic information about our school. We encourage you to apply early and make it a matter of prayer. Calvary Chapel Schools admits students of any race, color, and national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at our schools. Calvary Chapel Schools reserves the right to select students on the basis of their Christian worldview, lifestyle choices, academic performance, and personal qualifications including a willingness of the student and their family to cooperate with CCHS administration and to abide by its policies.

Applications & Application Fee: There is a non-refundable application fee of \$15 per student, with a maximum of \$25 per family. High school applicants are required to attach: a copy of their most current report card, a copy of their current high school transcript and a copy of their most recent test scores (SAT9, SAT10, or CTBS). Please return the completed application to the Calvary Schools accounting office with your application fee. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Acceptance Process: Please complete your application and submit it as soon as you have all the information needed. Once a completed application is received and processed by the accounting office, the application will be reviewed and evaluated. The sooner the application is processed the sooner the admission decision can be reached.

Info Night/Open House: Please join us on Monday, February 11, 2013 for Information Night; visit classrooms at our Open House on Thursday, March 7, 2013.

School Year: We have a traditional school year, September - June.

Tuition: Tuition for the 2013/2014 school year will be: Full-day Kindergarten \$7,000, Grades K-6 \$5,120, Grades 7-8 \$5,570, Grades 9-12 \$7,420. Multiple child discounts are: 2nd student \$500, 3rd student \$1,000, and no tuition charge for the 4th student on. For those who regularly attend and support Calvary Chapel of Costa Mesa, we will be offering a Calvary Chapel Costa Mesa family discount of \$600 per child. Tuition is payable in 10 monthly payments due the first of the month, August through May.

Registration: The yearly registration fee of \$400 per student includes student accident insurance, materials, yearbook, and curriculum. No portion of this fee is refundable.

Books: Textbooks and workbooks will be available for purchase from Jubilee Books. This service will buy back used books at the end of the year and will have new and used books available for purchase the following year. Cost will vary depending on classes taken - budget approximately \$375 for standard college prep courses, and more for advanced courses. Non consumable books may also be purchased independently. Reference our website at calvaryschools.org for the book list after June 10.

Extra Curricular/Athletics: All students pay a required ASB fee which gives them free entry to all league home sporting events, participation in various school sponsored activities, a class t-shirt for pep rallies, and a school planner. Calvary Chapel High School has a full athletic program. There is a general athletic fee for any student that plays a sport as well as spirit pack fees which vary depending upon the sport. Programs such as photography, drama and various other activities are available. Costs vary.

School Uniforms: All students are required to wear the approved uniform. Uniform pieces must be purchased through our contracted uniform company and can be ordered by accessing the uniform link through our school website.

Car Pools/Parking: Parents may submit an information card at registration time. The car pool information cards are indexed by city and then made available to parents to refer to in the elementary school office. Parents may then make their own contacts and arrangements. High School students who drive to school must purchase a parking permit for \$20 and park in designated areas.

Spiritual Life: Bible study, prayer, and worship are a part of student life at school. Students attend chapel weekly and Bible classes are included in our required classes for graduation. During the school day, students are encouraged to seek the Lord's will in every situation in their lives.
